Cost-Share Funding Available

The Logan County Soil Conservation District has received a grant through the North Dakota Outdoor Heritage Fund (OHF). The OHF was established in 2013 to provide grants that enhance conservation practices in our state. The OHF receives its funds from ND Oil & Gas Tax Revenue.

The program is called the Logan County Natural Resource Program (LCNRP) and will provide funding for both Grassland and Cropland practices. The cost-share rate on practices is 60% of actual costs and practices must follow NRCS specs and standards.

The first batching period will be from October 1, 2017 to February 1, 2018.
